POLICY FOR MASS INTENTIONS: The FCMM accepts offerings for Mass intentions. Those wishing to have a Mass said for a particular person or cause should contact or come to the Parish Office during regular working hours. On Sundays, if unable to pre-register, they **<u>must come 30 minutes before the Mass</u>** and register their intention/s with the Ministry of Offerings

FCMM's Policies regarding Mass Intentions

*Suggested offering - \$15.00 (minimum amount, but more is accepted) (make payable to FCMM) *The intention can be for a deceased person or a living person. Does not need to be Catholic.

* The Intention can be for another need of the Church: i.e. world peace, vocations to the priesthood and religious life, conversion of sinners, etc.

*A specific Mass time and date can be requested,

*The Mass intention is usually mentioned during the prayers of the faithful, but even if it is not, the Mass if offered for the intention will be posted in the bulletin.

* Each member of the faithful may offer the Mass for his or her own intention. The merits of the Mass are infinite.

*Mass Intention Offerings are **not** tax-deductible items. Donations and Special Mass sponsorships **are**.

PAGE 4 - 5th SUNDAY OF LENT

REFLECTIONS



Following the early Church Lenten catechetical itinerary, today we are invited to ponder on Jesus Christ's role in our existence as the "source of our life and resurrection." The death of Lazarus makes us reflect on the many forms of "death" that afflict mankind and which make us shed tears of sorrow and compassion. Jesus' calling Lazarus back to life portrays him as the conqueror of death, and foreshadows his own resurrection. The wonderful event of Lazarus' resuscitation is also a symbol of so many spiritual and moral "resurrections" brought about by Jesus. Grateful to him for the preciousness of these gifts, we entrust to him ourselves and the people who are emotionally or affectively or spiritually "dead."

May we all share in the fullness of his life, especially through the celebration of the Eucharist.

GENERAL LAW\$ OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE

CAN. 1249 All Christ's faithful are obliged by divine law, each in his or her own way, to do penance. However, so that all may be joined together in a certain common practice of penance, days of penance are prescribed. On these days the faithful are in a special manner to devote themselves to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, and to deny themselves, by fulfilling their obligations more faithfully and especially be observing the fast and abstinence which the following canons prescribe. **CAN. 1250** The days and time of penance for the universal Church are each Friday of the whole year

and the season of Lent.

CAN. 1251 Abstinence from meat is to be observed on all Fridays of Lent. Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

CAN. 1252 The law of abstinence binds those who have completed their 14th year. The law of fasting binds those who have attained their majority (18 years of age), until the beginning of their 60th year. Pastors of souls and parents are to ensure that even those who by reason of their age are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence, are taught the true meaning of penance.

PAGE 5- 5th SUNDAY OF LENT

REFLECTIONS



Last Sunday we reached the mid-point in our Lenten preparation. We celebrated "Laetare" Sunday last week and considered this "time of rejoicing" even as we continue our Lenten regimen of penance, sacrifice and generosity. Now, as we continue our Lenten journey, it is good to consider where we find ourselves on the road toward Jesus. So many of us really began this journey with high hopes and expectations, only to disappoint ourselves with our inability to remain faithful to the promises we made to ourselves and to the Lord.

Many of us have almost "given up" as we look to the empty

rice bowl that has ended up on the corner of the fire place mantle; or we consider with just a little shame how we have been unable to refrain from the dessert we gave up, or the cigarettes we promised not to smoke; many of us have rarely made it to the morning or evening mass or novena that we really planned to attend each week this Lenten season. We have two choices as we move toward these last weeks of Lent. We can "give up" or we can "begin anew!" All that is necessary to "begin anew" is the desire in our own hearts to do something for God as we continue to journey in Lent. We need to take just a few minutes and honestly assess where we are in our relationship with Jesus---examine our conscience and identify those obstacles that prevent us---that get in the way---of our desire to follow Jesus.

We need to ask if our own stubbornness or impatience or harsh attitude is keeping us away from God or God's people. We need to look for that old hurt or anger that is still "festering" in our heart. It is hard to be open to God's forgiving love when we won't make room in our hearts to forgive others.

We need to use these few remaining weeks of Lent as opportunities to meet Jesus Christ. We only need to re-commit to our Lenten promises to find our path so we can continue to journey with the Lord.

Today we need to be honest with ourselves and only then can we become honest with the Lord. We need to be unafraid to speak to the Lord: "Help me to get back on the path of my Lenten preparation." We just need to open our hearts to the transforming love and grace that God lavishes upon us---if only we let Him.

Today we can renew our Lenten promises---what did I promise to do for God each day--what did I promise to deny myself each day---how do I plan to be generous---how am I going to pray and worship? Don't be afraid to give Lent a "new start." Remember, God is waiting for you to ask Him to walk with you just a little further.
