On Sundays, if unable to pre-register, they **must come 30 minutes before the Mass** and register their intention/s with the Ministry of Offerings

FCMM's Policies regarding Mass Intentions

\*Suggested offering - \$15.00 (minimum amount, but more is accepted) (make payable to FCMM) \*The intention can be for a deceased person or a living person. Does not need to be Catholic.

\* The Intention can be for another need of the Church: i.e. world peace, vocations to the priesthood and religious life, conversion of sinners, etc.

\*A specific Mass time and date can be requested,

\*The Mass intention is usually mentioned during the prayers of the faithful, but even if it is not, the Mass if offered for the intention will be posted in the bulletin.

\* Each member of the faithful may offer the Mass for his or her own intention. The merits of the Mass are infinite.

\*Mass Intention Offerings are **not** tax-deductible items. Donations and Special Mass sponsorships **are**.


## REFLECTIONS





On this Third Sunday of Easter we journey with Jesus along with the two disciples of Emmaus to be enlightened by his explanation of the Scriptures and strengthened in our faith. Like tffent, We, දරුරු, will feel our hearts afire with love for him, we will recognize him in the breaking of Bread, and experience the urge to

share our faith with those who may still be doubting. Our intimacy with Jesus in this Eucharist should teach us to become compassionate fellow travelers of our brothers and sisters. It should make us what Jesus was for the disciples of Emmaus: people sincerely interested in their plight, ready to listen to them and to share with them our faith in the Resurrection.



We read in today's Gospel about an encounter between the Risen Christ and his disciples. Even these special persons who had received Jesus' personal attention were filled with awe, hardly able to believe the scene that was before their eyes. The Risen Christ---glorified in body---stood and spoke before them! Just try to imagine a similar scene in our own lives: how shocked we would be to meet with someone whom we had seen die and whom we had buried. But it really is Jesus, their friend and teacher standing in their midst. He assures them that he is not a ghost and he asks for something to eat. It must be Jesus, because ghosts don't eat. Jesus shares food with his disciples and then he continues to teach them. Just as Jesus was

present to his disciples in resurrected glory, so Jesus is present to each of us. Today, at this liturgy, he shares a meal with us. And just as he taught his disciples in the Gospel account, Jesus teaches us. We are still living our Easter experience! Jesus remains with us in a most powerful way, just as He was with his special disciples. We share Jesus in Eucharist at the altar. Jesus instructs us in the Scriptures---the Living Word of God! And just as Jesus was preparing his special disciples to continue His mission after he ascended to His Father, so he is preparing us to also continue His mission---spreading the Good News of salvation throughout the world.

Two thousand years after the first Easter event, we who are the followers of Jesus are reminded in the first Letter of John that we "know" Jesus and are charged to keep His commandments. As we continue to encounter the risen Lord in our own Easter experience, we are reminded today that our faith in Jesus is both a gift and a challenge. Jesus is present among us just as He was present to the special disciples of today's Gospel. This is truly gift! His disciples were charged then to preach in Jesus name to all the nations. And that is also our challenge today.

EASTERTIME...the eight weeks

after the Triduum are a season of "mystagogy" which means "the learning of mystery." But here, mystery

doesn't mean a puzzle to figure out - it means a new life experience. We "learn mystery," a lifelong task, by entering into and by living it. <u>Mysterion</u> is the Greek word for "sacrament." Sacraments are not something the church does to us. They are something that the whole church does, head and members - Christ and us. In other words, sacraments are forms of liturgy, "works of the



people." They are liturgical signs that point us toward God's reign, and so they are filled with layer upon layer of imagery. No wonder the Easter Season overflows with sacramental imagery. (Adapted from "To Crown the Year" by Peter Mazar)
