POLICY FOR MASS INTENTIONS: The FCMM accepts offerings for Mass intentions. Those wishing to have a Mass said for a particular person or cause should contact or come to the Parish Office during regular working hours. On Sundays, if unable to pre-register, they **must come 30 minutes before the Mass** and register their intention/s with the Ministry of Offerings

FCMM's Policies regarding Mass Intentions

*Suggested offering - \$15.00 (minimum amount, but more is accepted) (make payable to FCMM) *The intention can be for a deceased person or a living person. Does not need to be Catholic.

* The Intention can be for another need of the Church: i.e. world peace, vocations to the priesthood and

religious life, conversion of sinners, etc.

*A specific Mass time and date can be requested,

*The Mass intention is usually mentioned during the prayers of the faithful, but even if it is not, the Mass if offered for the intention will be posted in the bulletin.

* Each member of the faithful may offer the Mass for his or her own intention. The merits of the Mass are infinite.

*Mass Intention Offerings are <u>not</u> tax-deductible items. Donations and Special Mass sponsorships <u>are</u>.



PAGE 4 - 30[™] SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME REFLECTION



On this fourth Sunday of October, we are reminded about the two main moral obligations in life, namely to love God and our neighbor. Jesus is not only the wise teacher who restates the teaching of the Scriptures on this point, but also the one who put these two commandments into practice in the most perfect manner. Love of God and neighbor is really the "essence of Christianity." It is the golden rule of life which guides all believers in building up the Kingdom both in themselves and around them. In the Eucharistic celebration, let us ask God for the grace to keep the two laws of love together, and live them out, day by day as Jesus did.

This last Sunday of October is also the last Sunday of the Month of the Rosary and of the Missions. We continue praying for our missionaries, offering for them our Rosaries and our material support.



Look What Love Is Doing

Kids go through grade school and high school with important questions to face. Am I "in" with the crowd? Can I could hold my own against the bullies, can I get along with girls, did I wear the right clothes, am I cool enough? These were obviously more important and crucial than anything else in their lives. Have you discovered that love is quite a bit more than pretense, more than an ideal, more than just a thing we crave from others and certainly more than just pleasure? Have you seen that learning to love is the very air inhaled by such everyday

importances as work, relaxation, attractions, happiness? Without love's living atmosphere none of these could breathe, nor could we.

In this Sunday's <u>Gospel</u> Jesus says this in no uncertain terms. You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. You shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments. "What?" we might exclaim (as I did in college). We thought law consisted of commands forced upon us from the outside, rules whose violation would bring punishment. What is this about law depending on love? Well, take a look.

God does not fail at love. God waits. God says "how wonderful that you are learning!" God says, "I love every person on earth. And you: you are my beloved. I am at your side as you learn to open to me and to others."

You and I do not see ourselves as succeeding in this, so we need laws to help us. But the root of law and of life is fair care of others. It is loving concern under God for human persons. Ultimately it is an imitation of God's love for us.




