What child is this? This child is *light* dawning in the darkness of death. This child is *joy* in freedom from bondage.

\$200.00 (15%) \$30.00 \$200.00 (20%) \$40.00 **FEDERAL \$82.20** \$180.00 (29%) \$52.20 \$180.00 (24%) \$43.20 **PROVINCIAL \$83.20**

\$82.20 \$83.20 **Total Credits \$165.40**

TOTAL CREDIT IS \$165.40 or 43.50% of your donated amount.

EXAMPLE #2: For a donation of \$1000.00

FEDERAL PROVINCIAL Combined Computation

\$200.00 (15%) \$30.00 \$200.00 (20%) \$40.00 **FEDERAL \$262.00** \$800.00 (29%) \$232.00 \$800.00 (24%) \$192.00 **PROVINCIAL \$232.00**

\$262.00 \$232.00 **Total Credits \$494.00**

TOTAL CREDIT IS \$494.00 or 49.40% of your donated amount.

EXAMPLE #3: For a donation of \$2000.00

\$200.00 (15%) \$30.00 \$200.00 (20%) \$40.00 **FEDERAL** \$552.00 \$1800.00 (29%) \$522.00 \$1800.00 (24%) \$432.00 **PROVINCIAL** \$472.00

\$552.00 \$472.00 **Total Credits \$1024.00**

TOTAL CREDIT IS \$ 1024.00 or 51.20 % of your donated amount.

As shown above, give \$380.00 and get 43.5% tax credit;
Give \$1,000.00 and get 49.4% tax credit;

JESUS

The Most Holy Name of Jesus

It has long been a tradition to devote the month of January to our Lord's childhood — and His Most Holy Name! The letters IHS are an abbreviation of *Jesous*,

the Greek name for Jesus. "Jesus means in Hebrew: 'God saves.' In a world of fiercely guarded corporate names and logos, it should be easy to understand this feast.

At the Annunciation, the angel Gabriel gave him the name Jesus as his proper name, which expresses both his identity and his mission. Since God alone can forgive sins, it is God who, in Jesus his eternal Son made man, will save his people from their sins.' In Jesus, God recapitulates all of his history of salvation on behalf of men. The name of Jesus is at the heart of Christian prayer.

All liturgical prayers conclude with the words, 'through our Lord Jesus Christ.' The Hail Mary reaches its high point in the words 'blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.'

The Eastern prayer of the heart, the Jesus Prayer, says, 'Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.' Many Christians, such as St. Joan of Arc, have died with the one word, 'Jesus' on their lips." (CCC: 430 & 435)
